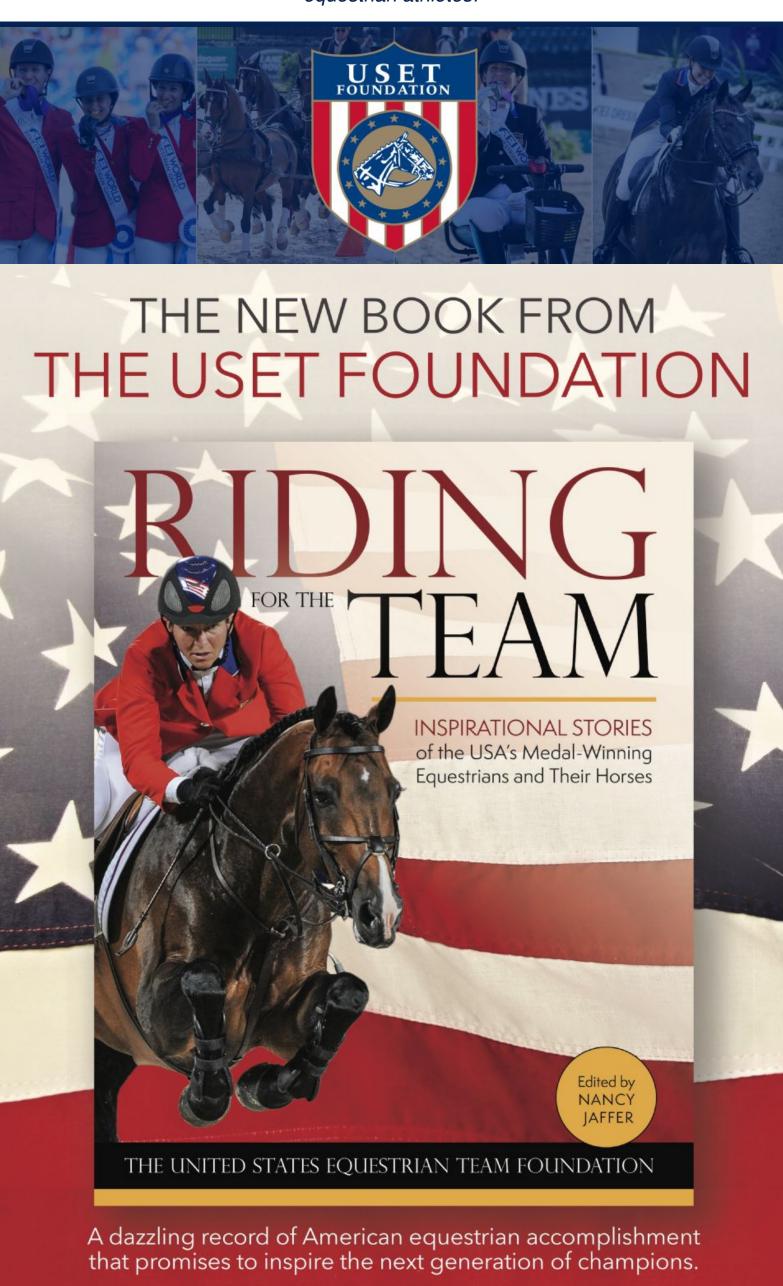
Support Team USA, and recount the compelling stories of 47 of the country's top equestrian athletes!
