Once registered, you will receive a text with your personal bidding link. This link will take you to the event's page to donate and place bids.

To watch an item, click on the heart next to the "Bid/Info" button, and it will turn yellow. This will place the item under your "My Items," when you click Menu on your main screen.

To bid on an item, click "Bid/Info" then choose to place the next bid by clicking "Fast

Bid" or "Bid/Set Max." To place the minimum bid, click the "Fast Bid" button and confirm the amount. To set a maximum bid, click the "Bid/Set Max" button. Next choose the amount you would like to bid then choose "Set Max." You can also bid a higher bid amount by clicking Bid This Amount. Note that the system will then continue to bid on your behalf until you reach your maximum bid.
