




## DEFHR at Horse World Expo

## Fort Frederick's Glow Up



In March 2023, DEFHR was called to support local law enforcement with the rescue and impoundment of neglected off-the-track Thoroughbreds living at a farm in Cecil County, Maryland. A gelding now known as Fort Frederick was one of those Thoroughbred horses rescued by DEFHR and brought to its Woodbine, Maryland, facility. When he arrived at DEFHR, it was clear that he was starving. He had a Henneke Body Condition Score of 1.5 out of 9 and was infested with lice.

Now, one year later, Fort Frederick is fully rehabilitated and will soon transition into DEFHR's training program to prepare him for his future forever home. To support our life-saving efforts or to view horses currently available for adoption, click the buttons below.

## Featured Horse of the Month: Peter Piper




18-year-old Tennessee Walking Horse gelding, 15hh
