In the evening's opening panel, featured experts - including Olympian Daniel Bluman, US Equestrian Show Jumping team veterinarian Dr. Tim Ober, threetime winner of the USHJA International Hunter Derby Championships Liza Boyd, FEI groom for Millar Brooke Farm Danny Ingratta, and innovator in equine rehabilitation Dr. Sheila Schils - will discuss what it takes to proactively manage a horse's soundness and how a mindful approach can improve your horse's well-being and reduce the risk of lameness. The one hour discussion will also cover topics such as the impact of stress on horses and what to do when things go awry.



Competing at any level of any sport comes with its share of mental stressors, and at the highest levels of equestrian sport, the psychological component can make or break a rider's ability to perform their best.

Event attendees and live stream viewers will hear first-hand from riders including World Equestrian Games team show jumping gold medalist Adrienne Sternlicht and Olympic bronze medalist and number five ranked dressage rider in the world Kasey Perry-Glass, alongside moderator and Mental Skills Coach Tonya Johnston, MA - on topics including handling stress and nerves, building confidence, finding a routine, imposter syndrome, being present, surrounding themselves with the right people, and more.

Those in attendance will also have the opportunity to ask their own questions regarding the mental and emotional challenges of the sport during this panel and open discussion.
