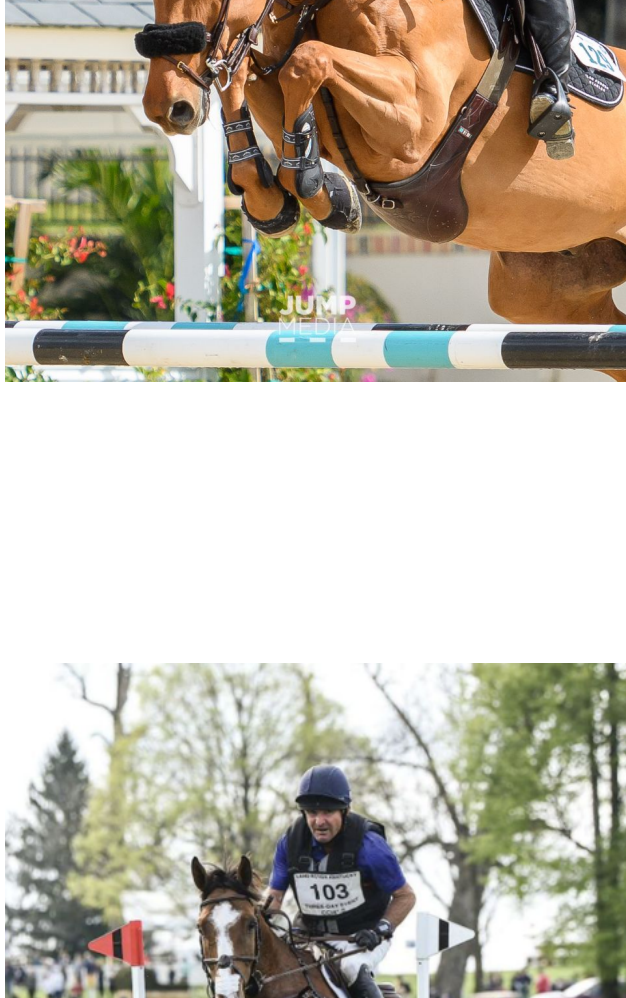

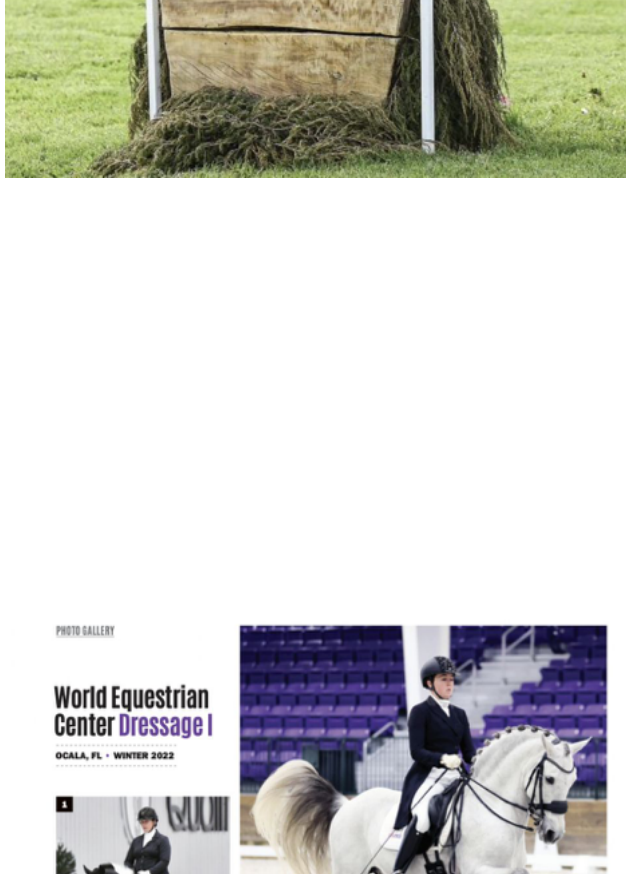
#### Pro Pop Quiz With Erynn Ballard: How Do You Ensure a Successful Outcome When Catch Riding?

As Sidnee Ledyard went to collect Quasi Cool from his paddock at Phillip Dutton's winter base in Loxahatchee, FL, on the morning of February 5, 2022, she could tell something wasn't right. The gelding hadn't touched his grain, and when she approached him, she noticed that his nose was bleeding.

She reached up to slip his halter on, and "Quasi" spooked and didn't want her touching his face. Upon removing his black fly mask, she determined the cause. Overnight, Caroline Moran's 11-year-old Holsteiner (Quo Vados—B-Estelle, Lord) had broken his right orbital bone, and due to the swelling, his eye was protruding from the socket with the iris facing down.

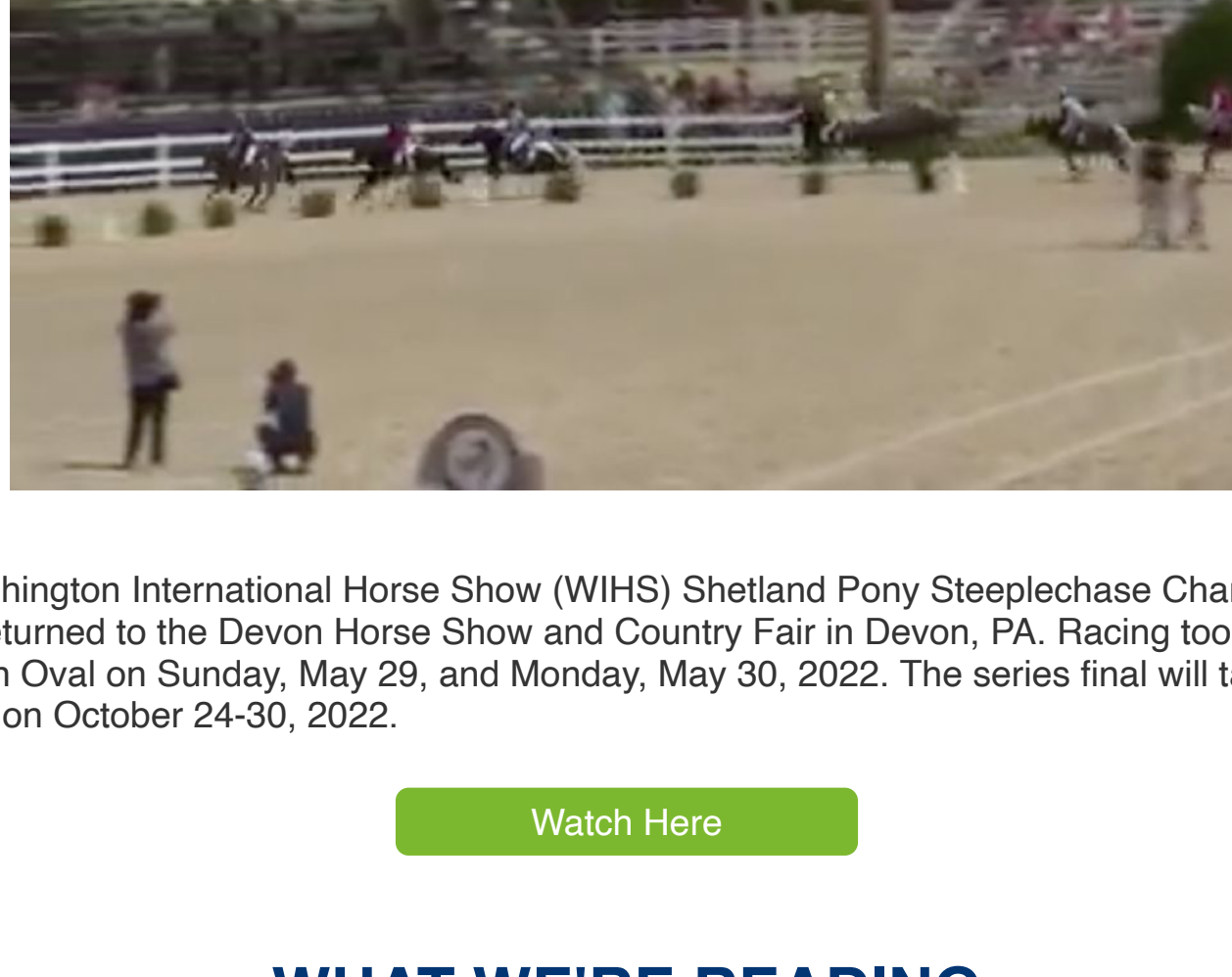

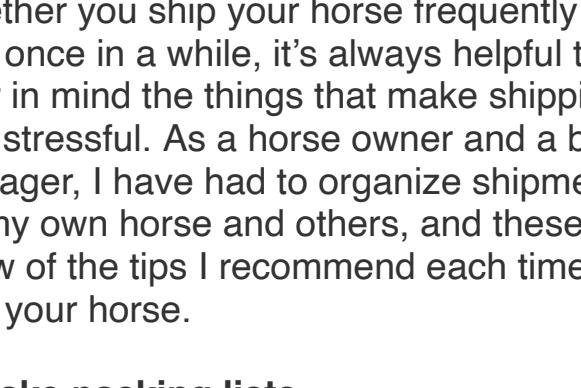

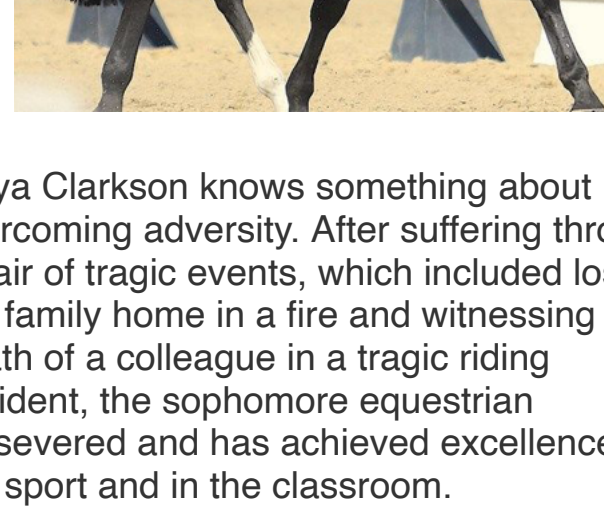
##### 1. Make packing lists.

#### Training Helps Rescues Focus on the Future

When Gideon, a Quarter Horse gelding in his twenties, and his 18 herd mates first arrived at Days End Farm Horse Rescue (DEFHR), Woodbine, MD, in January 2021, their situations were desperate.

Animal control and law enforcement officials discovered the horses living in deplorable conditions on insufficient acreage in St. Mary's County, MD. DEFHR was contacted to assist by providing the resources needed to quickly intervene and seize the horses.

#### New FEI Solidarity Relief Fund Initiatives for Ukraine

A recent visit by a Ukrainian delegation at the Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) Sports Forum 2022 in Lausanne, Switzerland, sees additional initiatives and projects approved for funding by the FEI Solidarity Relief Fund.

The dedicated CHF 1 Million Solidarity Relief Fund for Ukraine has been actively supporting a number of equestrian-related schemes across Ukraine and neighboring nations receiving Ukrainian horses and athletes. This includes the creation of a logistical hub in Granat, Ukraine, to prepare horses for transfer into the European Union; funding and distribution to regional hubs of critical horse supplies such as feed and bedding; and the emergency evacuation of a Vaulting team.
