Five years ago Ilan Ferder came to Erynn Ballard with a proposition. For her entire professional career, Ballard had worked at her family's Looking Back Farm in Tottenham, ON, splitting her time between the jumper and the hunter ring, but Ferder's offer to join his team was enticing.

"You get to a stage where maybe your priorities change a little," said Ballard, 41. "In Canada, there are not very many big owners that support just the sport, and it was hard to do the level that I wanted at home. And he gave me an opportunity that I couldn't turn down.
