Volunteers will be there to direct you to the area. • Vendor Days and Hours of Operation: October 7-9, from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. Vendor Parking: Vendors can park in the parking lot behind the unloading area
- on a first come, first served basis. A professional parking service will be on hand to assist with parking. • Shipping and Deliveries: Email Christy Baxter to arrange deliveries at <u>christy.baxter@wec.net</u>. All shipments are the responsibility of the recipient who cannot hold WEC liable for any losses or damage. Any costs for shipments
