Over the last century and a half, we've had the rare opportunity to witness standout achievements by women in gender-blind athletic contests.

In 1967, Kathrine Switzer became the first woman to complete the Boston Marathon as an officially registered competitor. In 1973, Billie Jean King crushed Bobby Riggs in straight sets during the "Battle of the Sexes" tennis exhibition match.

Now, some 50 years later, women are once again having a moment in the most audacious of equestrian disciplines: five currently sit in the top 10 in the Fédération Equestre Internationale Eventing World Athlete Rankings.

Upendi's Race to Happily Ever After

In August 2022, Upendi (Swahili for "love") arrived at Days End Farm Horse Rescue (DEFHR) in Woodbine, MD, with an uncertain future.

The then-24-year-old Thoroughbred mare had raced in her early life under the name ShowMeToTheStorm, earning \$5,430 from her nine starts and, years later, was seemingly discarded by her owner.

Upendi was seized by animal control officers from her pasture in St. Mary's County, MD, after a concerned onlooker informed the county of her dire state. When animal control arrived, it was clear that she was severely underweight, had sustained several injuries and wounds, and had not received veterinary care.

The Halo Project

BREED. RIDE. EVENT.



After Amanda Chance's friend Bobby lost his long-time equine partner, a super offthe-track-Thoroughbred (OTTB) named Halo, she had an idea: The Halo Project. The goal is to crowdfund an annual scholarship that gives the money raised to a rider on an OTTB to help cover the costs of participating in either US Dressage Finals, the USEA American Eventing Championships, or the Thoroughbred Incentive Program Championships. Riders would apply with a short essay and photo, and Bobby and the Board would pick who receives the scholarship.
