Canada's 103rd Royal Agricultural Winter Fair once again brought the country to the city with the Royal Horse Show. A wide variety of livestock and agricultural exhibits added to the ambience of the world's largest indoor fair, and horse-sport fans witnessed the best competing for national championships and international accolades. Steeped in tradition, the event preserves the history and timeless elegance of a bygone era with box holders and other

dignitaries dressed in black-tie. From the Canadian Show Jumping Championships on opening weekend to the sold-out Longines FEI Jumping World Cup Toronto on closing night, spectators were treated to 10 days of horse sport. Ireland's Conor Swail emerged victorious in the \$200,000 Longines FEI Jumping World Cup Toronto after jumping off against a pair of 21-year-old Americans, Skylar Wireman and Mimi Gochman, who finished second and third.
